

# Venetian Top Bun (15th C)

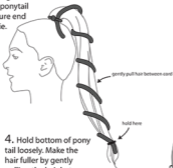
You will need:

Hairbrush or Comb  
Bobby Pins  
Thick hair tie  
Thin Hair tie  
About 3+ feet of cord

1. Brush hair thoroughly and pull up into a tight ponytail at the top of head, just above the crown, and secure with a thick hair tie. Tease the ponytail to give it more volume.

2. With cord, tie one end around base of pony tail, and allow long end to hang with hair.

3. Using the long end of the cord, wrap ponytail evenly and secure end with thin hair tie.



4. Hold bottom of pony tail loosely. Make the hair fuller by gently pulling the hair between the cord wraps.

5. Arrange hair directly on top of head in a loose circle. Use bobby pins to pin into place. Tuck end of hair into the base of the pony tail. If you have loose cords, you can tuck them under as well, or allow the two ends to hang loose from the back of the bun.
